On October 8th, 2014, the Judicial Hearing of *State v. Ramirez*, the Attorney General announced he created the position of Lieutenant Attorney General. *Only the Student Body President may create other cabinet positions*, per Chapter 301.1 § F:

Chapter 301: Composition of the Executive Branch

- 301.1 The Executive Branch shall be composed of:
 - F. Other Cabinet offices that the President deems necessary

Chapter 302.3 further outlines your administrative duties, and subsection C outlines your responsibilities to immediately notify me in writing the creation of a new position.

Chapter 302: The Executive Branch

- 302.3 Administrative Authority
 - C. If a new Executive Branch position is created, the President must notify the Senate President in writing, immediately, of its creation.



<u>I did not receive written notification.</u> Therefore, I am filing a Judicial Complaint against you regarding this violation.

Transparency and accountability are paramount to serving the Student Body in a professional manner in keeping with the positions we hold. **This oversight demonstrates noncompliance and negligence of duty.**
